

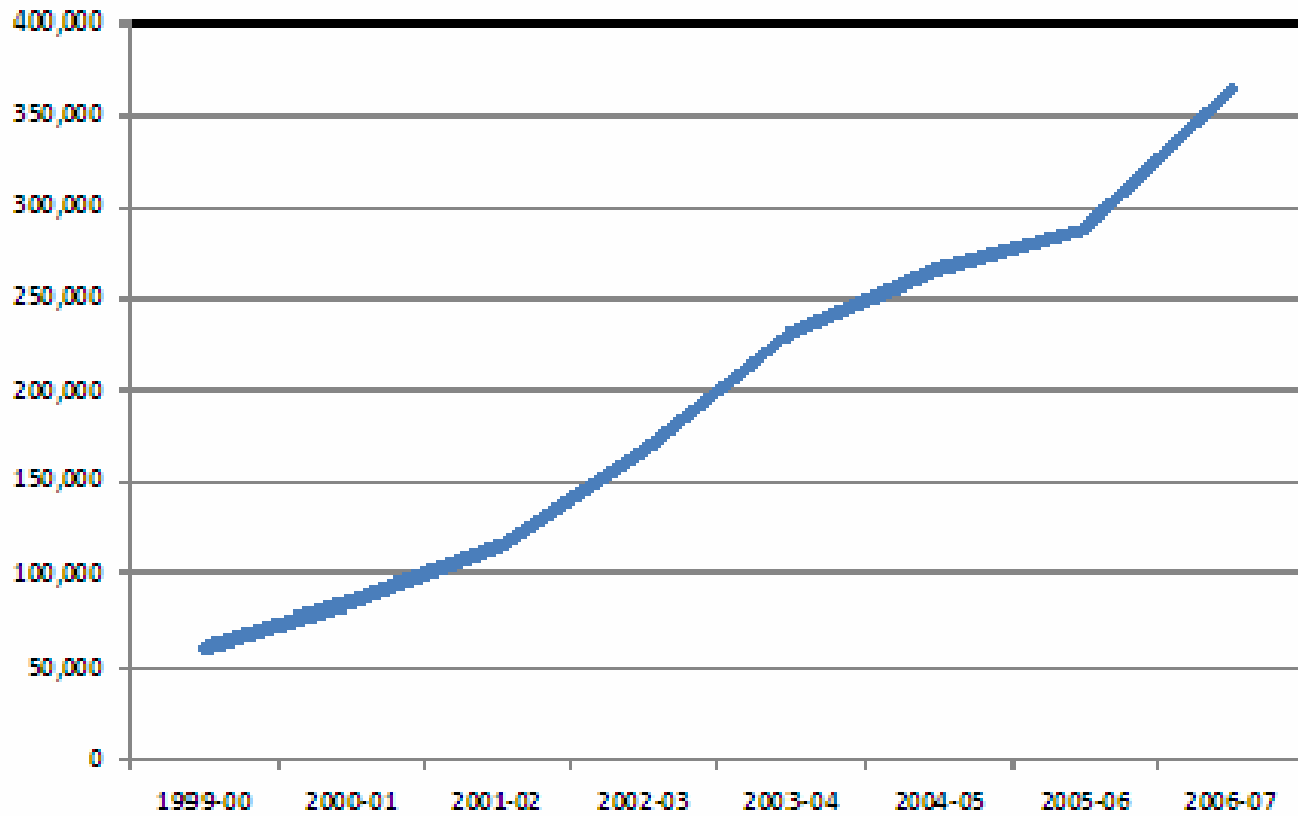

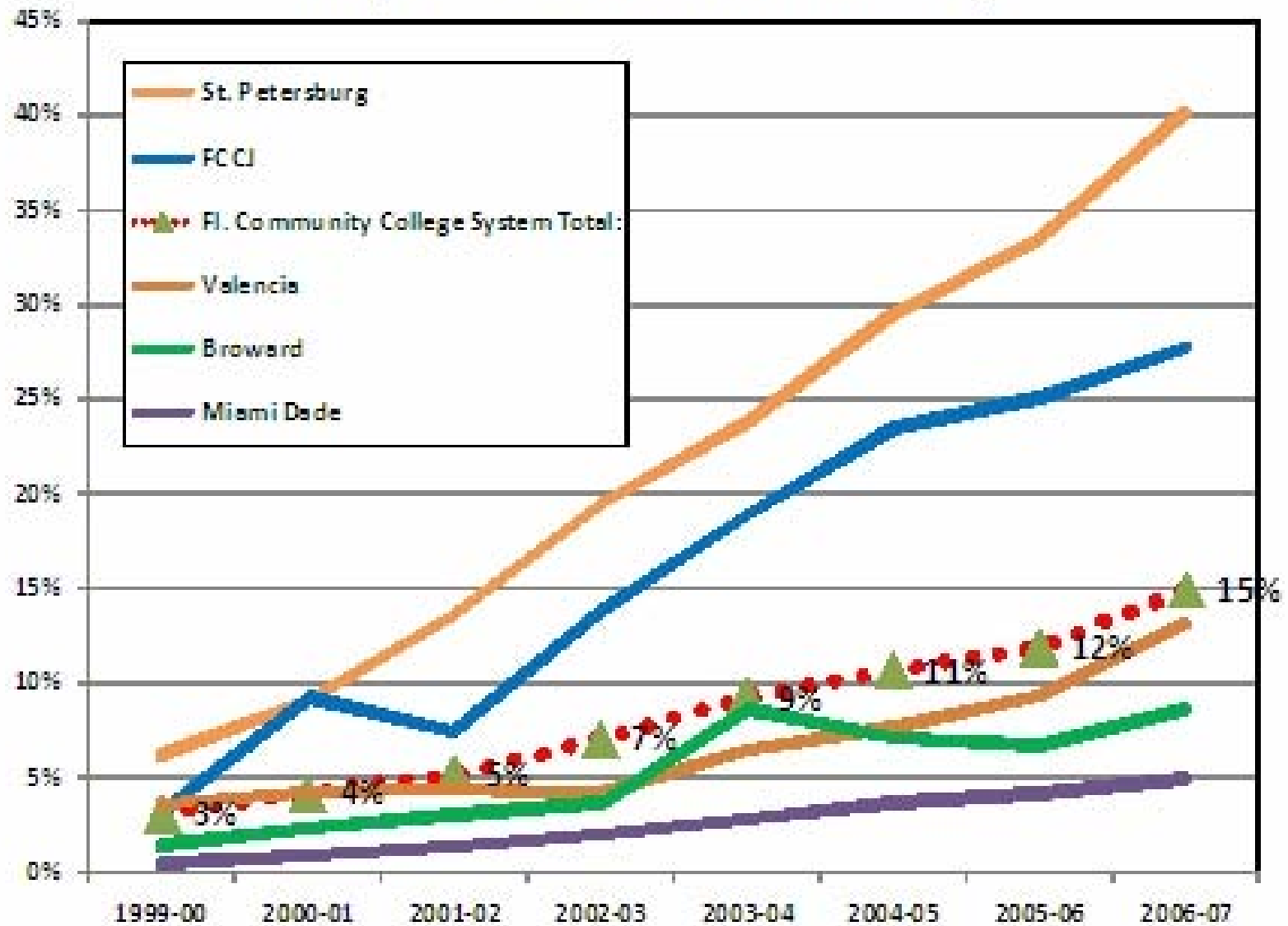
Distance Learning: Community College System

- For 2006-07 there were 364,718 enrollments in distance learning courses.
- This is an increase of 26 percent over the prior year. (30,000 new enrollments)
- Several colleges experienced large enrollment increases last year in response to demand.
 - Daytona Beach 12,000 to 25,000
 - Palm Beach 12,000 to 22,000
 - Valencia 19,000 to 27,000
- Distance learning is 15 percent of credit enrollment - up from 12 percent last year.

Distance Learning in the SUS: Current Data

Students 2006-2007

- 152,137 enrolled in at least one DL course
 - *Up 16%* in one year
- 17,514 enrolled only in DL courses
 - *Up 29%* in one year
 - Equal to UNF in 2006
- 50, 823 enrolled in technology mediated
 - *Up 7%* in one year

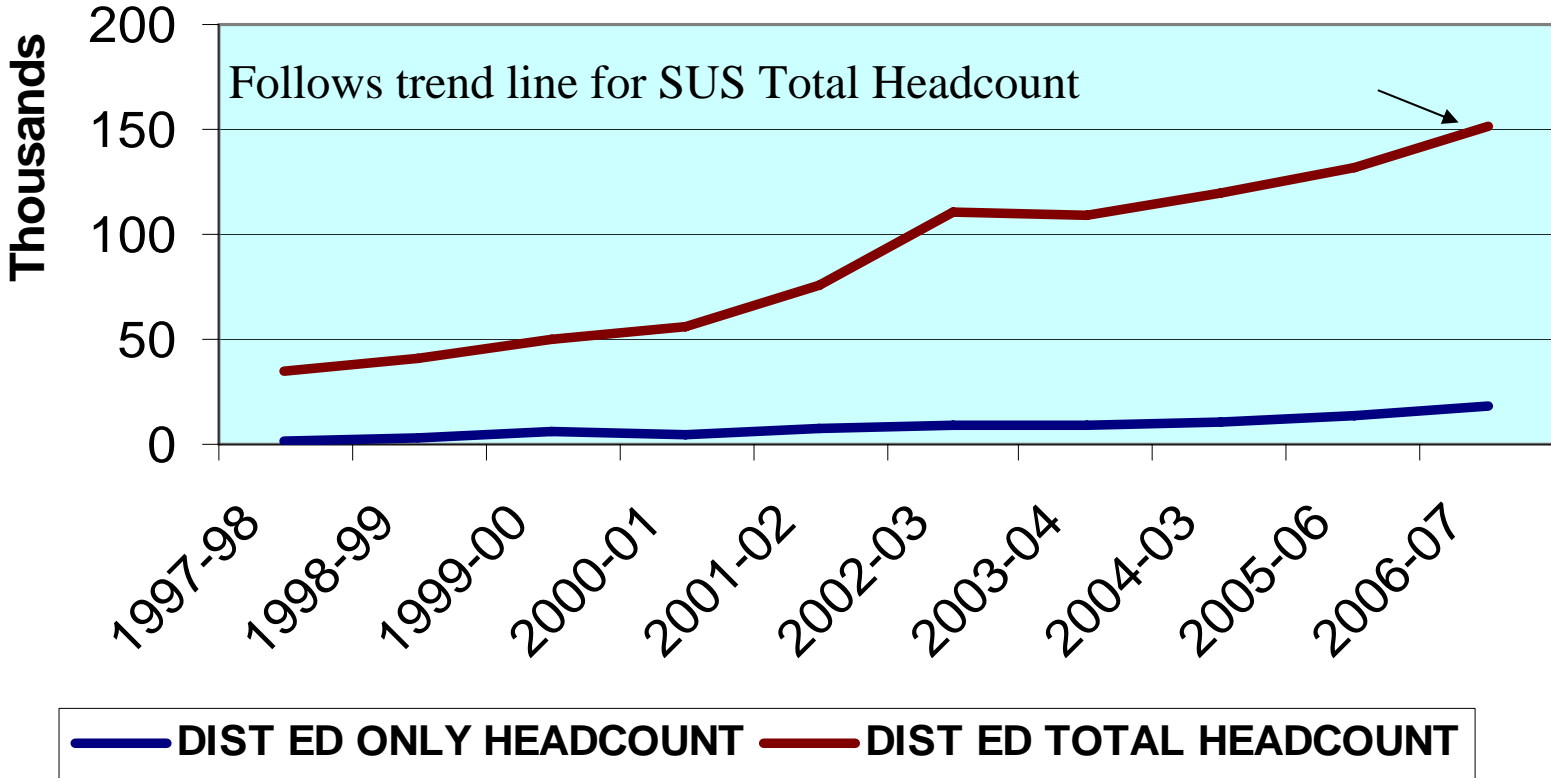

- 84 Certificates

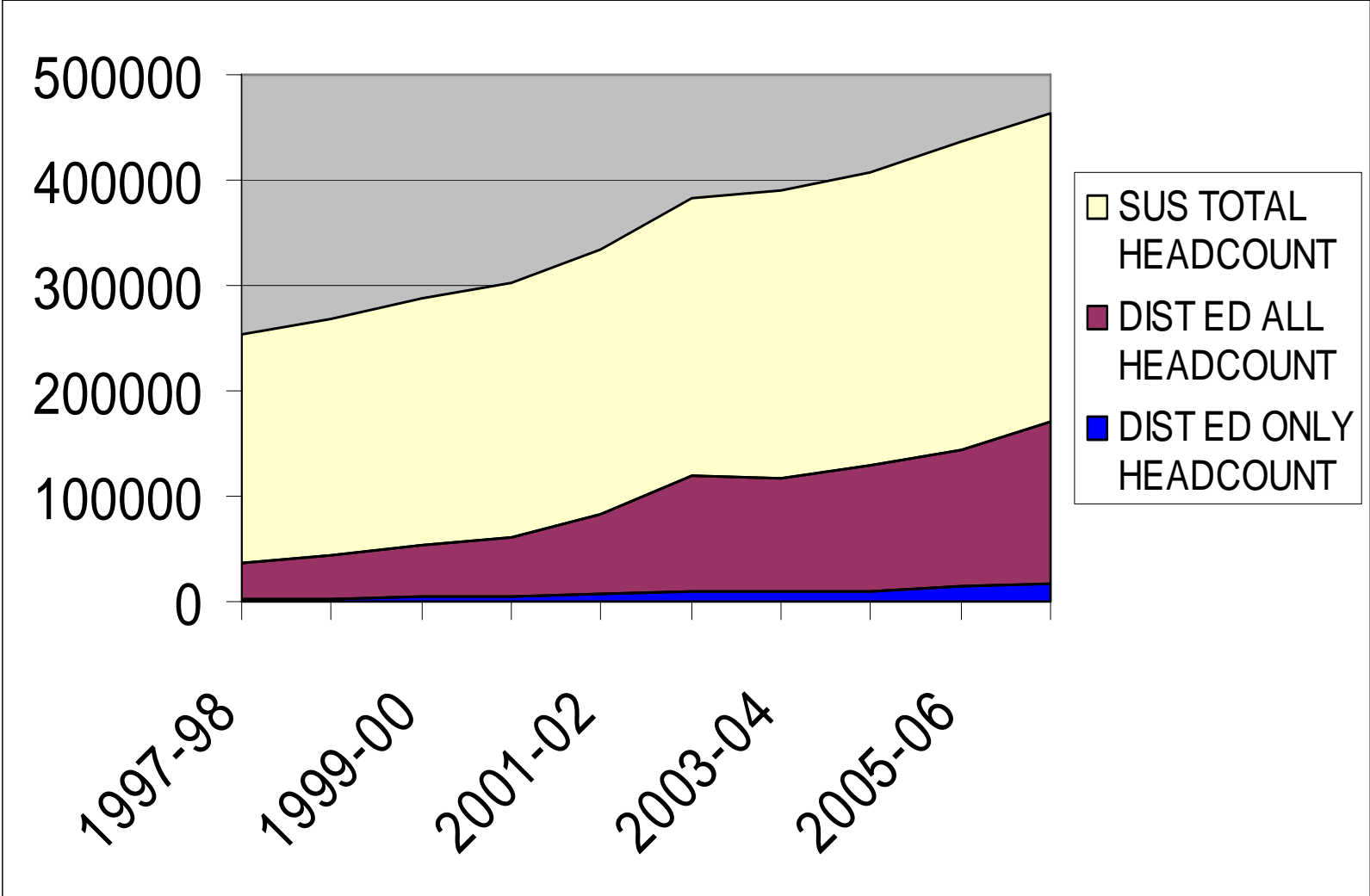
- **Distance learning and blended instruction is 23 percent of total SUS instructional activity.**

State University System Unduplicated Headcount in Distance Education Courses

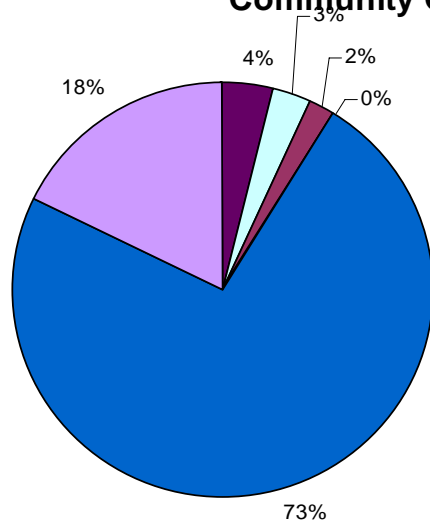

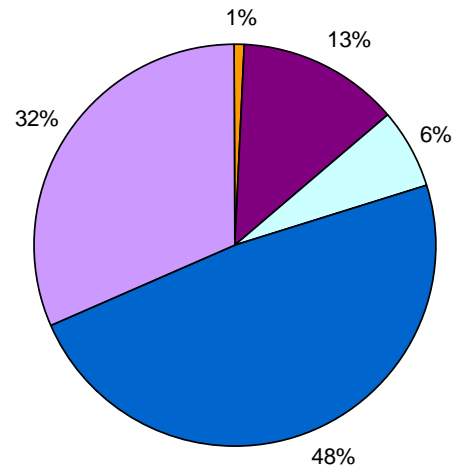
